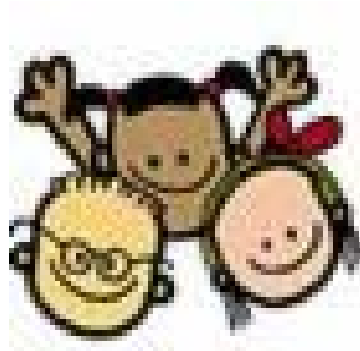




Ways to Enjoy Reading

We are asking each child to read one book this summer from each of the following two categories :

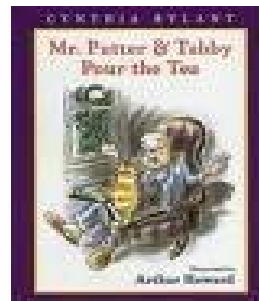
