Input Devices:

The process of entering information into a computer.

Output Devices:

The process of displaying, printing, or sorting information produced by a computer.

Storage Device:

If you want to store your efforts for future retrieval, you must copy the work from memory to a storage device *before* turning the computer off. This process is called **SAVING** your work. When your work is saved it creates a computer **FILE**.
