FACE Scholarships & 18-19 Registration, Scholarships & Fees

Re-registration letters will be headed home next Wednesday 1/17/18. You should have started the FACE Scholarship application process on your FACTS account and needs to be submitted by March 1st. If you don’t have access to a computer please call the office and we can help. All those presently accepting in house financial aid recipients are required to apply for the FACE Scholarship and the Hope and Opportunity Scholarship.

The calendar raffle drive to offset the tuition gap and operating costs remains at \$250 and 5th grade graduation fee will remain at \$150. The registration fee remains at \$175.
